And to—just below it was a picture of this beautiful Angelus Temple, which is a... quite a long ways that the church has come from that day to this, from the old mission to this place.

4 And I think the association has selected a wonderful place to hold this rally, because this temple stands today as a memorial to a little mother, who felt that down in her heart that Jesus Christ still lived and reigned, Mrs. McPherson. She sleeps up in Forest Lawn today, her body, but her gallant soul is at rest with God: and partings leave behind her, footprints on the sands of time.

<u>64</u> Listen. What was it? About fifty years ago, on Azusa Street in California, a bunch of people were worshipping God. Methodistism had got so formal and indifferent until they didn't want none of what they call fanaticism; no shouting, no amen, no nothing in the church. They thought that education and reformation would reform the people to a place that they didn't need this stuff anymore.
